We are currently having kind of a slow month so I wanted to remind you of the free services we can provide to you and your clients and encourage you to send referrals our way!! We are passionate about serving our community and empowering women to gain economic independence.

Listed below are the services we offer designed for job seeking or recently employed women, people who identify as women, or prefer female clothing:

- Interview and Employment Suiting's - 1 on 1 hour long appointments for professional attire
- Career Center Services - 1 on 1 hour long appointments with a Career Coach
- Haircuts - we have about 3 haircut slots per week available to clients
- Professional Women's Group - group of alumni clients that meets once per month for workshops
- Special Offers - Financial Literacy courses, 1 day workshops, etc

In order to refer clients to us all you have to do is fill out our referral form (find attached) and send it to [seattle@dressforsuccess.org](mailto:seattle@dressforsuccess.org) from your work email. Once we receive the referral, we will contact your client directly to book an appointment.
